

Sailing Racing Rules Item 63.1 and Appendix A. When such penalties are applied, the details are specified in the Sailing Instructions.

- **Scoring**

The regatta will be considered valid after at least 3 races are held. If 4 races are held, the worst result is rejected.

- **Advertising**

The World Sailing Advertising Code applies. Boats may need to bear decals of the official regatta sponsor as provided by Organizer.

- **Boats of coaches and observers**

All motor boats with coaches and regatta observers need to be approved by Organizer during the entry procedure. All persons handling boats with coaches and regatta observers are obliged to present a third-party civil liability insurance for the amount of at least EUR 500,000.

- **Mooring spaces**

All boats and equipment need to be stationed in areas specified by Organizers.

Launching of pontoons and the trailer park: Mrzeżyno port at ul. Portowa 6, Mrzeżyno

- **Radio communication**

Racing yacht crews may not use radio communication, text messages, mobile phones and communication devices other than those provided by Organizer.

- **Prizes**

Detailed rules of prizes will be announced on the day of the regatta.

- **Disclaimer**

All participants take part in the regatta at their own risk. See rule 3 'Decision to participate in a race'. No action taken or not taken by Organizers will release the participants from liability for damage caused by competitors or their yachts as a result of their participation in the regatta.

- **The right to use the image**

By entering the regatta, the competitor (or legal guardian in the case of underage children) consents to free use of their image (photos, videos and other content) by organizers, sponsors and partners of the event. Competitors may be required to give interviews during the regatta.
